How Do I Enroll?

- Apply to EGCC by visiting - <https://freecollege.usw.org> and select the "Get Started" button
- Complete the FAFSA form online by visiting [FAFSA.ed.gov](https://fafsa.ed.gov) - be sure to include EGCC's school code 007275
- Submit proof of high school or GED completion
- Schedule an advising appointment to enroll with courses with the help of one of our Enrollment Specialist.

The USW Free College offers a debt-free and convenient higher education opportunity for current and retired union members, and their families. Family members do NOT need to be financial dependents or living with the member to be eligible.
