# WHY ENGAGE YOUNG AND NEW MEMBERS?

## OUR STRUCTURE

The NextGen program is designed to empower local unions through a structured approach:

### 1. LOCAL UNION NEXTGEN LEADER

Each local ideally has at least one young member leading the program, supported by a committee based on local size and membership density

### 2. DISTRICT NEXTGEN COORDINATOR

Appointed by the District Director, this coordinator helps build and support the program.

### 3. INTL. NEXTGEN STAFF SUPPORT

Staff from the USW International office provide guidance and resources to enhance local and district initiatives.

ACTIVISM TAKES MANY FORMS; SOME MEMBERS CHOOSE TO LEAD AS LOCAL PRESIDENTS OR CHIEF STEWARDS WHILE OTHERS ENGAGE IN DIFFERENT CAPACITIES. THIS DIVERSITY IS ESSENTIAL TO STRENGTHENING OUR UNION BOTH INTERNALLY AND EXTERNALLY.

ENCOURAGING OUR YOUNG AND NEW MEMBERS TO ACTIVELY PARTICIPATE IN EXISTING USW PROGRAMS IS VITAL FOR A VIBRANT UNION COMMUNITY.

Encouraging our young and new members to actively participate in existing USW programs is vital for fostering a vibrant union Community.

Additionally, members can engage with their Provinces and Territories Federations of Labour, Fédération des travailleurs et travailleuses du Québec (FTQ) and Labour Councils as part of The Canadian Labour Congress is an effective way to connect with the broader labour movements and campaigns. They may also participate in various affiliated organizations such as the Coalition of Black Trade Unionists (CBTU) and the International Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans, and Intersex Association (ILGA). These engagements provide members with opportunities to advocate for diverse issues, support inclusive policies, and collaborate on initiatives that promote equality and workers' rights across different communities.

This structure was finalized by the International Executive Board in 2019, following extensive testing. It mirrors other successful activist groups within the union, such as Women of Steel and Rapid Response.

The core of NextGen lives in local union committees. Local union NextGen leaders can help shape each group in a way that best serves the local community. Each USW district has a lead coordinator, often supported by regional coordinators focused on specific areas. These

coordinators collaborate with staff to ensure effective program development and resource access.

Our commitment extends to mentoring the next generation of activists to ensure a sustainable future for our union and the labor movement. The NextGen program includes community service, education, legislative action, organizing, and social activism. By providing training and networking opportunities, we prepare and inspire young activists to become invaluable members of the USW.
